15. Nyetimber Classic Cuvée	West Sussex	England		£45.00
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Be one of the very first to try this brand new release vintage from English sparkling wine supremos, Nyetimber! Nyetimber's most recent release offers a younger wine than usual. Still with 4 years bottle ageing, the Classic Cuvée is a fresh and vibrant wine with a lovely amount of fruit. The nose has delicious strawberry notes as well as a soft yeastiness. The palate opens up to juicy tropical flavours including lychees and mandarin.

16. Nyetimber Rosé	Vintage	West Sussex	England	£50.00
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The rosé is a superb example of what we can do best here in England. Chardonnay and Pinot noir varieties made in the traditional Champagne method provide the huge amount of fruit (redcurrant and cherries) present on the nose and palate. This fruitiness is balanced perfectly by the lees-aging brioche notes, as well as the acidity and unabating length.

22. Terrazas Reserve Chardonnay Tupungato Terrace Argentina	£5.95	£8.95	£35.00
Yellow with golden hues. Subtle white roses notes stand out over lemon zest, pear and white peach aromas. Then little more complex notes such as ripe pineapple and hazelnut appear. It reveals great sucrosity and mouth-filling texture.

30. Paul Mas Domaine Astruc Viognier Languedoc South West France £27.50
 A lovely subtle, complex style of Viognier – with fresh apricot and white peach hints, and a rich, aromatic Palate Located in the Languedoc, 23kms south-west of Carcassonne, Domaine Astruc was bought in 2003 by Jean- Claude and Michel Mas, themselves owners and winemakers of the successful independent Les Domaines Paul Mas.

31. Gavi 'La Battistina' Piemonte Italy £30.00
 Aromatic, zesty nose with apple, lime and kiwi notes and a hint of minerality. Juicy, weighty fruit with a zippy, citric acid mouth watering feel creating a refreshing, satisfying finish.

33. Chablis La Chablisienne Burgundy France 35.00
 Pale straw with green glints. Fruity and floral on the nose with citrus notes. On the palate the wine is fresh and beautifully balanced, with good ripe fruit and a long, exquisite mineral finish

34. Lugana Tommasi 'Le Fornaci' 100% Turbiana DOC Piedmonte Italy £32.50
 Tommasi is located in Pedemonte in the heart of the historic 'Classico' region, from which the best quality wines are produced. The estate is owned and managed by the fourth generation of the Tommasi family, with six family members working together in harmony. Pale yellow in colour, this wine has delicious perfumes of tropical fruit.

35. Sancerre Langlois-Chateau Loire France £45.00
 Founded in 1885 by Edouard Langlois and his wife, Jeanna Chateau, Langlois-Chateau is considered the premier winery of the Loire Valley. Now owned by Champagne Bollinger, the winery is best known for its elegant Crémant de Loire sparkling wines and for its still wines from the region, including Sancerre. This well known appellation is the birth place of Sauvignon and also the best spot to grow it.

36. Astelia Chardonnay Jean Claude Mas Languedoc Sud du France £55.00
 This is the highest quality Chardonnay from Domaines Paul Mas, one of the greatest modern domaines in the Languedoc. A bright golden wine, offering aromas of pineapple, quince, hazelnuts and subtle toasted bread notes. Soft on the palate, with good acidity in the background and a persistent finish. **Has a hint of top end Burgundy!!!!**

37. Pouilly Fuisse Louis Latour Burgundy France £55.00
 An elegant wine showing a green gold colour and delicate aromas on the nose. On the palate there is a round and full herbal fruitiness that compliments the crisp acidity leading to a satisfying finish.

38. Rioja Marquis de Murrietta Capellania White Reserva Spain £55.00
 Bags of character on both the nose and palate this is one of the great white wines of Rioja Oak aged for a full elegant finish this wine is dry yet packed with flavour. Superb with all fish dishes

39. San Perito Merlot Chile £3.25 £4.50 £16.95
 Soft structured wine with full rounded fruit flavours of raspberry, cherry and ripe plum, balanced with caramel and vanilla oak characters.

40. Richmond Ridge Cabernet / Shiraz Australia £3.50 £4.75 £19.00

- 41. Terrazas Reserva Selection Malbec Mendoza Argentina** £5.95 £8.95 £35.00
A wine of great structure and body with mature tannins. Distinguished for its sumptuous character, robust volume and concentrated fruit, also displays an attractive complexity and a long mouth.
- 42. Goru Organic Monastrell Jumilla Spain** £3.75 £5.50 £22.50
It has a lovely lifted aroma of fresh berry fruits, raspberry and cherry in particular. The palate is full in flavour but not too powerful and has wonderful mouthfeel and texture. Notes of sweeter fruits come through on the finish and its a very satisfying wine.
- 43. Don Placero Sin Crianza Rioja Tempranillo Spain** £3.75 £4.95 £19.50
This bright red Rioja benefits from 3 months in oak and punches well above it's weight in quality with lovely berried fruits nicely integrated with a smoky wood background.
- 44. Louis Latour Pinot Noir Var France** 5.00 £6.00 £28.00
A fabulous wine from the Var region, north of St. Tropez. This wine has a light ruby colour and an elegant perfumed bouquet. The palate is rich and smooth with a distinctive red berry fruit character.

Reds By the Bottle.....

- 45. Cerro Anon Rioja Crianza Spain** £28.00
Made from 100% Tempranillo, this wine spends 12 months in new fine grain American Oak and over 6 months aging in the bottle.
- 46. Paul Mas Domaine Astruc Cabernet Sauvignon Reserve Languedoc Roussillon France** £28.00
Part of an excellent range of single varietals from a Paul Mas-owned Languedoc estate, bucking the local tradition of blended wines. Concentrated, pure Cabernet Sauvignon, New World-influenced, but a whiff of southern French hillsides. Good with red meats and tomato-based pasta.
- 47. Mc Henry Hohnan Margret River Shiraz Margret River Australia** £29.50
Medium bodied with gentle, ripe tannins and a rounded finish The fruit is rich and earthy with rounded plum and bramble fruit supported by farm yardy characters and herbal hints. A restrained red that bears well with grilled and roasted meats and game.
- 48. The Pepper Pot Syrah Mouvedre Tannat Stellenbosch South Africa** £29.50
Made from grown grapes only in the Stellenbosch region, this wine is created to show the fresh, fruity and spice driven flavours of these Rhone varietals. The colour is youthful and purple/red. The nose is one of crushed black pepper, dark mulberry and mixed berry coulis.
- 49. Whitehaven Pinot Noir Marlborough New Zealand** £35.00
Sweet lifted aromas of cherries and plums, with a hint of currants. Attractive floral notes also appear integrated with savoury mushroom and toasty oak.
- 50. Domaine Les Cres Ricards Syrah Grenache Appellation Coteaux du Languedoc France** £37.50
A deep ruby colour and a complex bouquet of spices (peppercorns and cinnamon), tobacco, mocha and stewed blackcurrants. On the palate it is full-bodied, velvety, toasted and fruity (blackcurrant backed up by black cherry), with a particularly liquorice finish.
- 51. Marques de Murrieta Tinto Reserva Spain** £40.00
Aged in American Oak Barrels for 2- 3 years and another 2 years in bottle Marques de Murrieta Reserva is the essence of Rioja. The results are a silky smooth wine with subtle well integrated oak flavours and great elegance.
- 52. Astélie Cabernet Sauvignon Languedoc Rousillon Sud du France** £50.00
Astélie wines come from the best vineyards across Jean-Claude Mas's eleven estates, farmed sustainably and according to biodynamic principles. Astélie Cabernet Sauvignon comes from two

fruit and mocha aromas, leading into a rich and elegant flavour.

53. Cloudy Bay Pinot Noir Marlborough New Zealand £54.00
 Appealing at once, the nose of this benchmark Pinot Noir is ripe with plum, aromatic spice and red florals. The palate is focussed with a savoury architecture; bittersweet chocolate, dark fruit and spice play with leather and hints of earthiness. Chalky tannins linger on a persistent finish

54. Amarone La Colombaia Italy £50.00
 Typical aromas of ripe fruit, fruit preserve and cherry are immediately perceived on first olfactory examination. Particularly striking is the incredible long length that lingers on the palate, when the wine displays all its strength through a warm and elegant body.

55. M.Chapoutier Châteauneuf-du-Pape Le Bernardine £60.00
 Intense crimson-red. A complex and subtle nose of blackcurrant and plum followed by roasted coffee and cinnamon, cherry and morello cherry. A spicy palate with liquorice and fruity characteristics.

56. Marqués de Murrieta Gran Reserva Rioja Spain £60.00
 With a deep blackcurrant colour, the nose is fragrant and perfumed; the wine has notes of black fruit, truffle, violets and cigar box. The palate is firm and intense but balanced with mouth-coating tannins and a sweetly seductive finish.

57. Chateau de Pez, Saint St Estephe, 2008 Bordeaux France £60.00
 Appearance : bright, dense, with a deep shimmering colour. The wine has a powerful toasty nose with hints of freshly roasted coffee. The palate is strong and intense with persistent aromas of black fruit.

58. Chateau de Pez, Saint St Estephe, 2009/10 Bordeaux France Magnums £110.00
 bright, dense, with a deep shimmering colour. The wine has a powerful toasty nose with hints of freshly roasted coffee. The palate is strong and intense with persistent aromas of black fruit.

59. Louis Latour Pinot Noir Var France Magnums £ 48.00
 A fabulous wine from the Var region, north of St.Tropez. This wine has a light ruby colour and an elegant perfumed bouquet. The palate is rich and smooth with a distinctive red berry fruit character.

60. Louis Latour Grand Ardeche Chardonnay France Magnums £ 48.00
 After 12 months ageing in small oak barrels, this wine – made from 100% Chardonnay– displays fresh, rich fruit flavours, with the extra dimension added by the judicious oak ageing.

61. Angus The Bull Cabernet Sauvignon Australia Magnums £ 48.00
Goulburn Valley 27% / Barossa Valley 26% / McLaren Vale 14% Strathbogie Ranges 9% / Central Victoria 6% / Langhorne Creek 5% Heathcote 5% / Swan Hill 5% / Other 3%
 Intense colour with bright purple hues. Ripe black fruits with rich dark chocolate and vanillin smoky oak aromas. Medium to full bodied palate weight, characterised by firm tannins and a savoury masculine finish. An ideal accompaniment to red meat and premium cuts of prime beef.

62. Rural par Nature Blanc 'Jean Claude Mas' Languedoc France £3.75 £5.50 £22.50
 The wine has a pale yellow color, the taste has hints of pineapple, citrus, stone fruits, hazelnuts, vanilla with a light roasted tone and a fresh finishing with crisp acidity., perfect for tasty salads, grilled and fried fish and dishes with white meat or poultry.

63. Rural par Nature 'Jean Claude Mas' Languedoc France £3.75 £5.50 £22.50
 The classic southern Rhone blend of Grenache, Syrah, Mouvedre and Merlot gives this wine great depth and richness. superb with roast dishes but light enough to be enjoyed on its own.

Dessert Wines

63. Chapoutier Muscat de Beaumes de Venise France **125ml**
£7.50
The wine is a glittering gold colour with honey and apricot scented, citrusy aromas backed up by a clean, vibrant freshness on the palate.

Port Selection

64. Ramos Pinto Reserva Collector Portugal **50ml**
£3.00

One wine up from standard Ruby Port, Collector is a blend of old and new vintages creating a 5 year old blend with a sense of power, fruit and red berries. A delightful wine that can be enjoyed in the mid afternoon, slightly chilled in hotter weather or as a stunning accompaniment to chocolate puddings !

65. Ramos Pinto Late Bottled Vintage Portugal **£4.50**

LBV comes from one single year and one single harvest. Whereas its richer cousin, the Vintage, is bottled in the second, this wine is bottled in the fourth year. Smoother than the Vintage, more developed, easier to drink its a powerful, defiant , full bodied and harmonious wine.

66. Ramos Pinto Quinta de Ervamoira 10 year old Tawny Port Portugal **£7.50**

Red Brick in colour, with a palate of oriental spices, this multi award winning Tawny Port has spent the majority of its aging time spent in oak which oxygenates the wine to give it a lighter, warmer more feminine style

67. Bodaga Numanthia Toro Spain Tinta del Tora (Tempranillo)
125 ml Glass £10.00 Bottle £60.00

NOSE

This intensely aromatic wine displays black fruit, particularly blueberry and black currant, accompanied by notes of fig and sweet cream pastries. Hints of black pepper and clove add spice to the toasted hazelnut aromas.

PALATE

An intense, robust and vivacious wine with phenomenal structure. Impressive fruit expression together with perfectly ripened tannins lead to a meaty mouthfeel. A long and persistent finish of tobacco leaves and balsamic notes highlight the complexity and handcrafted character of this wine.

68. Cheval des Andes Argentina
Malbec, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot and Petit Verdot
125 ml Glass £14.00 Bottle £80.00

Cheval des Andes is the first fusion of the Premier Grand Cru Classé A of Saint-Emilion – Cheval Blanc, with its savoir-faire, and Terrazas de los Andes, with the best Argentine high-altitude terroir, and its expertise in producing Malbec and Cabernet Sauvignon. The philosophy of successive harvests directly addresses the synergy born as a driving idea to bring toget

AROMA

An aromatically fresh and refined wine, with outstanding notes of black cherries and black currant. Then, notes of wild blackberry jelly, with subtle menthol and spicy tones such as the bay leaf appear. Complexity and elegance with subtle notes of cinnamon arise due to its aging in oak barrel

PALATE

Vibrant and precise Delicate and silky tannins balanced by a seductive acidity are combined with elegant notes of red fruits and tobacco. Long persistence is developed with a clear exhibition of the characteristic freshness, purity and elegance of this Millésime 2010 of the Grand Cru of the Andes
